
Dear Ms Felton:

My son, Fernando Bilvar, received individual tutoring from Certified Learning Centers, Inc. (CLC) during the academic year 2004-2005. In addition to working with basic math facts and the sequencing of mathematical skills, your instructor strengthened Fernando's pre-algebra and algebra skills, so that his grade in Algebra One improved greatly from an "E" to a final grade of a "C". Your instructor consistently strengthened his weak calculation skills by teaching him to identify skill lags, reinforcing the math skills he was learning in school, assisting him to complete his homework, and preparing him for his math tests. Fernando also learned to apply the mathematical study skills in the Certified Learning Centers' Math Study Skills Curriculum including: Listening Is a Mathematical Skill, Problem Solving, Understanding the Language of Mathematics, Learning From Your Homework, Using Formulas, Estimation, Preparing for a Test, and Taking a Math Test.
